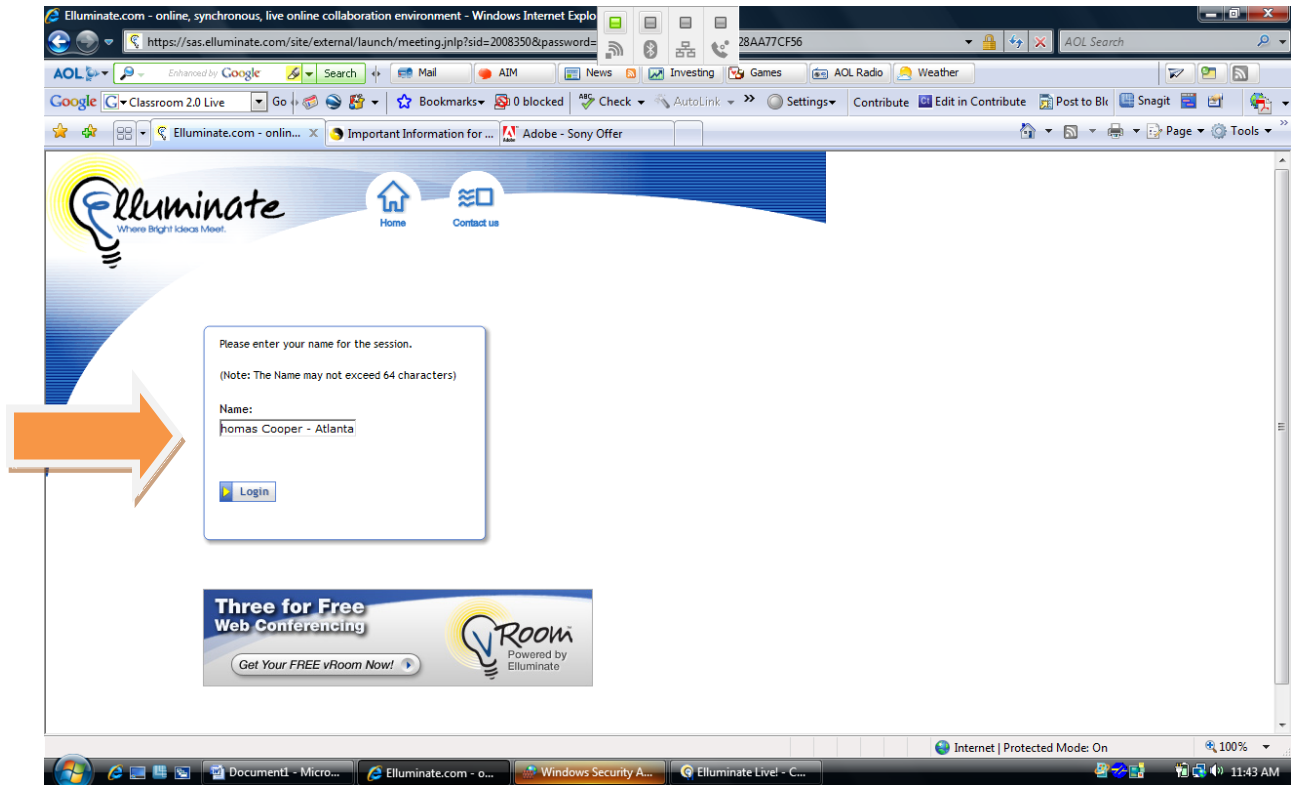

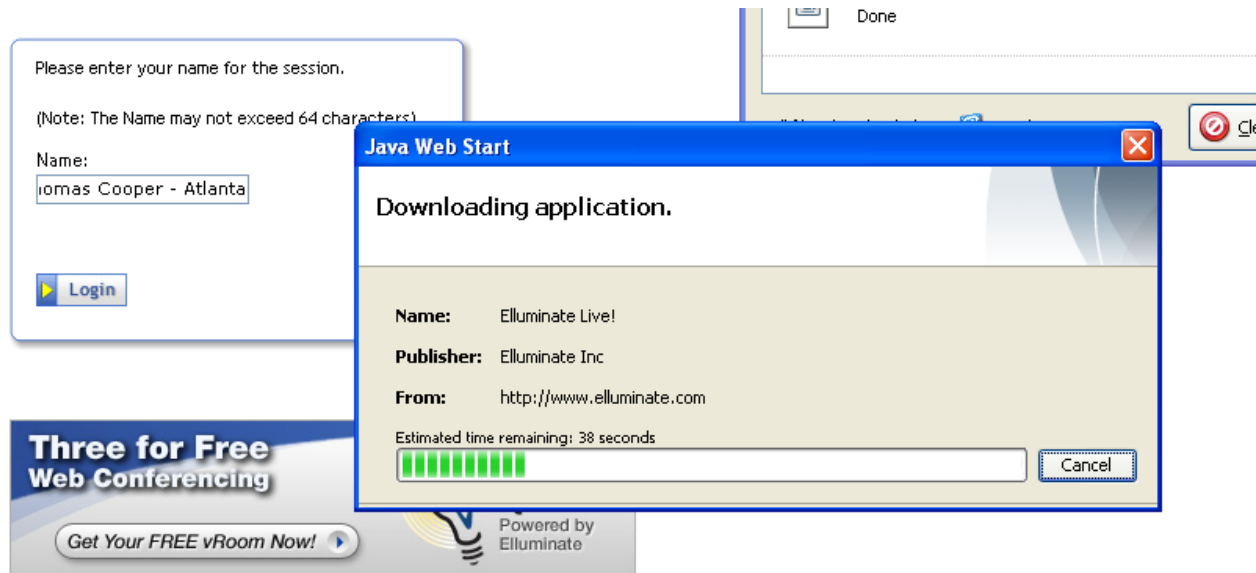


3. Scroll down on the page and look on the right side of the page to see what this week's topic is. There is a live session each week on Saturday's at 12 noon EST (11 am CST).

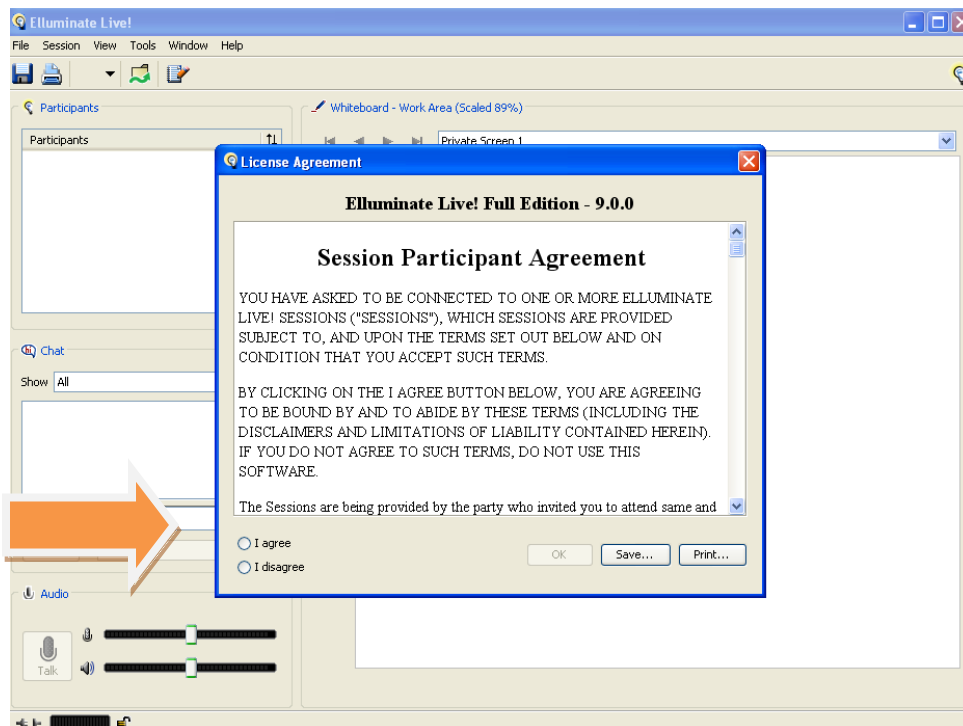
4. To enter the session, click on the link below the sign. This link will take you to the session start screen.



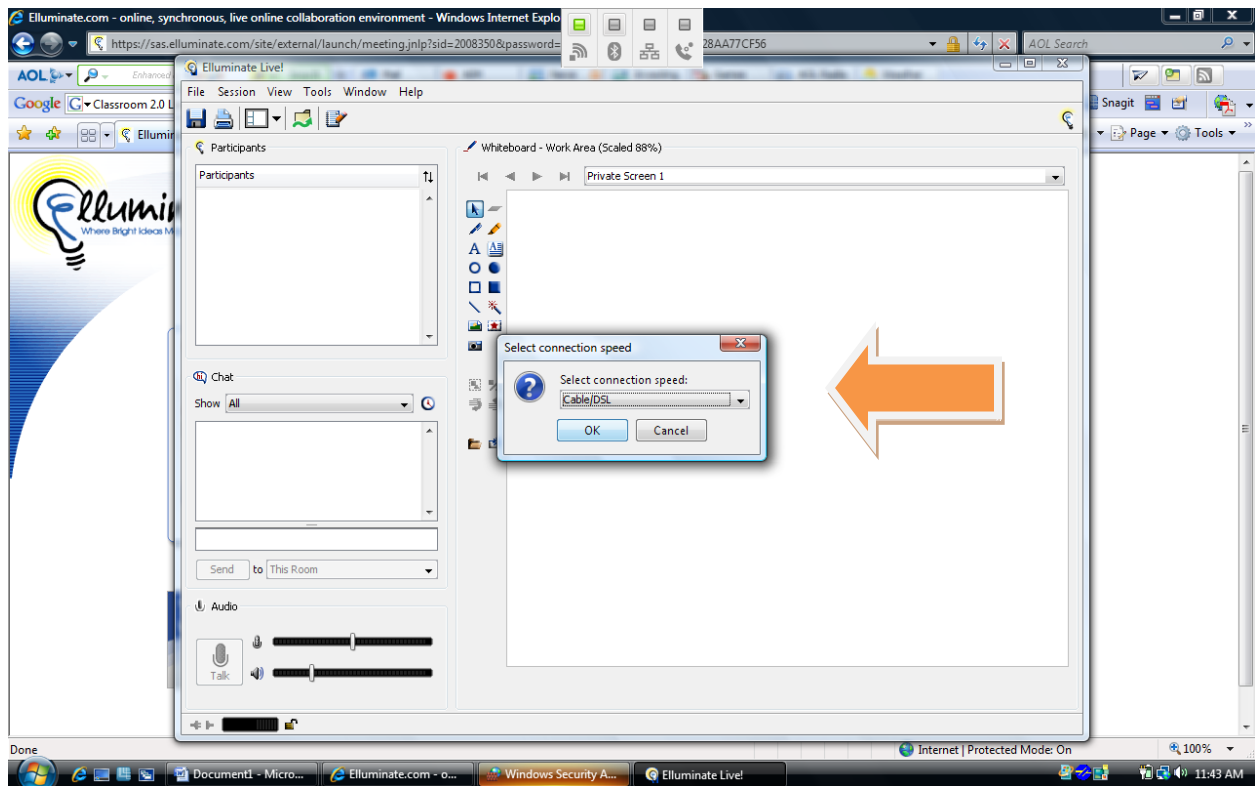
5. Enter your name in the blank under "Name". I suggest using your first and last name plus the city where you are from. Depending on the session there may be more than 50 people in the session and it is helpful for the hosts and the participants to be able to discern one Tom from another Tom. It is also helpful to see where everyone is from by including your city (ex. Thomas Cooper – Atlanta).
6. Click "Login" when you are ready to enter.



7. If you have never used Elluminate before, it may take a couple of minutes for the site to download the software to your computer.



8. Click on the "I agree" radio button and then click on "OK" to enter the site.



9. When you first enter Elluminate, it will ask you to choose a connection speed from the drop-down box as shown above. Choose the speed that matches your modem speed. For instance, if you have Cable or DSL, choose that from the list. If you are at school and your school has a T-1 line or a network pipe, then choose LAN from the list.
10. Click "OK" to confirm the connection speed.
