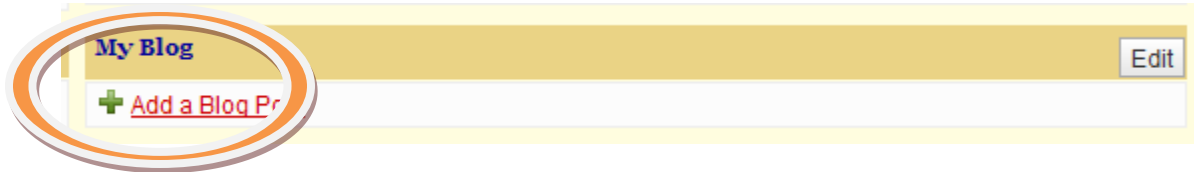
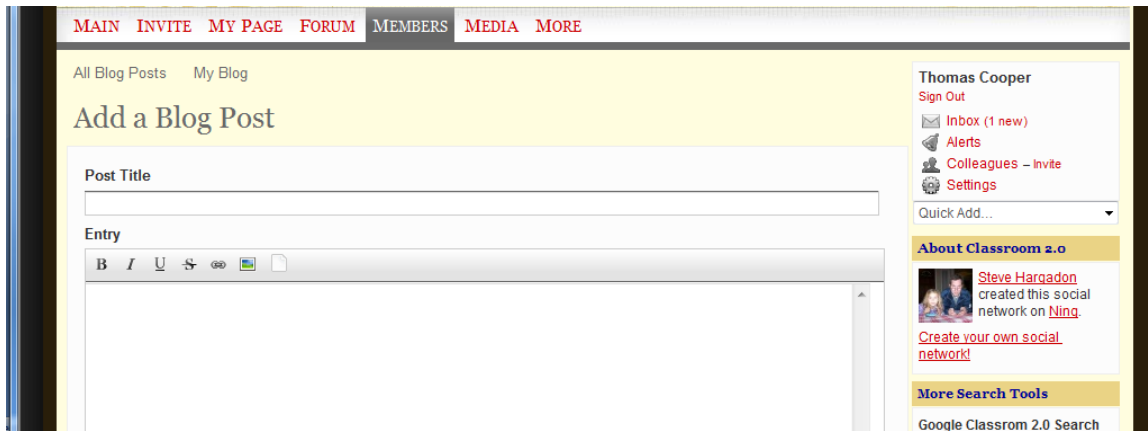




1. Click on "My Page" in the menu bar for Classroom 2.0




2. Scroll down to the middle of the page and click on "Add a Blog Post".

5. Scroll down and choose "Now" for the date of your post. In the future you can use the time and date boxes to choose a future date for posts if you don't want your post to be published immediately.
6. Choose "Just My Colleagues" from the Privacy and Comments sections.
7. Choose "Just My Colleagues" from the "Who can comment on this post" section.
8. Click "Publish Post" to post your first blog.
9. NOTE: You can "Save as Draft" if you want to save the post for a later date, or "Preview" it if you want to see how it will look before it's published.
10. NOTE: Most social networks give you a few minutes after your post to go back in and edit your post. To edit you post, click on the "Edit" button near the pencil. This will allow you access to the title and text of your post so you can make any changes.
